**Directions**: From the Everett Turnpike:

Take Exit 2 off the Everett Tpk.and follow the signs towards Hudson going over the Merrimack River. After crossing the Merrimack stay in the right lane and turn onto Rt. 3A South (Sam's Club on right and Wal-Mart on left).

At 3<sup>rd</sup> set of lights stay straight (right lane) to continue on Rt. 3A. Go about 1½ miles to next lights. (Watch for HFGC sign.) Turn left at

lights onto Pine Rd. Club is ¼ mile on left.

**Rules**: Competitors must select which match to compete in:

Open (Any sights)

• Junior (Metallic sights only)

- NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern.
- Use of ECI (empty chamber indicator) is mandatory.
- Ear protection is mandatory.
- Eye protection is strongly recommended.

Competition Open To:

This match is open to all current NRA members. Junior competitors may be either an individual NRA member or a member of an NRA affiliated club.

Match Entry Fees:

Match entry fees:

- \$30.00 for Open match
- \$25.00 for Junior match
- Team entry is \$9.00 for an entire team.

## This includes:

- NRA registration fee of \$5.50
- State registration fee of \$3.00.

**Entries:** Call the contact person on the first page to reserve an entry. Entries are

not final until payment by check has been received. Make checks payable

to the contact person. Entries close Saturday, September 13.

New Hampshire resident competitors will have entry preference over non-

residents.

**Post Entries** Post Entries will be accepted until the relay is called to the firing line. A

Post Entry fee of \$3.00 will be added.

**Entry Limit**: The match is limited to 36 competitors. 18 per relay maximum.

**Relays:** Two alternating relays:

Relay 1: 9:00 AM

Relay 2: 9:45 AM (approx)

Classifications: The NRA classification system will be used. A Tyro class will be available

for Juniors who have no NRA Rifle discipline classification.

**Teams:** An unfired <u>three</u> person team match is available. Pickup teams are

allowed. A team may register until the relay for any one team member is called to the firing line. No team may be created that includes a competitor

who has already fired.

**Awards**: State Champion awards will be available for:

High scoring resident Open competitor.

• High scoring resident Junior competitor.

The following awards are available for all other competitors. regardless of residency:

 50% of Open entry fees (minus cost of trophies/awards) will be returned to Open, non-Junior competitors in the form of cash awards based on participation and classification.

- Classification awards will be available for Juniors.
- Classification awards require two or more competitors. Classification groups will be combined up as needed.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place award if six or more in a classification. 3<sup>rd</sup> place if 11, etc.
- A Team award is available if two or more teams enter.

**Course of Fire**: All shots fired on A-51 targets as follows:

• 40 shots Prone – 20 minutes each target

40 shots Standing – 40 minutes each target

• 40 shots Kneeling – 30 minutes each target

Relays alternate after completion of each position above.

**Equipment:** Any .22 caliber rimfire rifle conforming to NRA rule 3.2.

Junior match competitors: Metallic sights only conforming to NRA rule 3.7a.

Open match competitors: Any sights conforming to NRA rule 3.7c.

**Meals:** A gas grill cookout of hamburgers, hotdogs, salad, chips and soda or water

will be available from 11:30 to 4:00 for all competitors and guests. Cost will

be \$5.00 per person.
