Classifications: NRA Classification system will be used. Temporary classification scorebooks are acceptable. Classes with less than 5 entries will be combined with the next higher class.

Entries: Advance entries are suggested due to range capacity. Only one relay will be fired.

Match 2 – 40 shots Standing, Metallic Sights
Match 3 – 40 shots Kneeling, Metallic Sights
Match 4 – Iron Sight Aggregate (Matches 1-3)
Match 5 – 40 shots Prone, Any Sights
Match 6 – 40 shots Standing, Any Sights
Match 7 – 40 shots Kneeling, Any Sights
Match 8 – Any Sight aggregate (Matches 5-7)
Match 9 – Grand Aggregate (Matches 4 & 8)
