

Saturday, April 25, 2009 NRA Outdoor 3-Position Conventional Smallbore (3x40) Open & Junior Hosted by Quaker Hill Rod and Gun Club



Range: Quaker Hill Rod and Gun Club, 261 Oxoboxo DamRoad, Oakdale CT 06370, A 16 Point Covered Range with convenient parking. Kitchen will be open and serving beverages and light fair.

Time/Squadding: 1st relay 9:00 AM 2nd relay (if required) 9:30 AM (Advanced squadding is recommended)

<u>Course of Fire:</u> Official NRA A-23/5 at 50 yards, shooters will mark and hang their own targets. **Metal clips are re**quired to hang targets and backers, 12 clips are recommended.

Match 1: 40 shots Prone Match 2: 40 shots Standing Match 3: 40 shots Kneeling

Match 4: aggregate (agg.) of Matches 1, 2 and 3
Match 5: Team Match (two person Paper Teams)
Match 6: Junior Team Match (two person Jr Paper Teams—irons only)

Sights:Open — ANYSIGHTsJunior — Metallic "Irons" Sights onlyJuniors may shoot Anysights but will be eligible for Open awards only.

## Eligibility:

**<u>Rules:</u>** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern the conduct of this tournament. ECI's (Empty Chamber Indicators) will be required and made available if you need one.

**<u>Classification</u>**: NRA classification card or temporary book (NRA Rule 19.6). Those without either will fire in the master unclassified class. Classes will be combined to the next higher class if there is less than 5 competitors.

- **Fees:** NRA Registration Fee \$5.50, Match & Club fees \$18.50—Total Individual fee **\$25.00** Team entry \$8.00/ 2 man team. (paper match, aggregate from match 4) Checks should be made payable to Lisette Grunwell (NRA Award points will be accepted)

**<u>Challenges:</u>** \$1.00 fee per match for a competitor's own match; \$3.00 fee per match for another competitor's match. The fee is returned if the score changes. Shots already plugged will not be re-plugged. The use of plug type scoring gauges will be restricted to match officials only (i.e., Scorers and Jury members).

**<u>Awards:</u>** Awards are dependent on the number of entries. At least 50% of the match fees will be returned to the shooters for the individual matches and at least 80% of the team fees will be returned in the form of awards. A minimum of 5 entries are required to form a class. 2nd place awards will be presented if 6 or more entries in a class and 3rd place awards will be given if there are 12 or more. Match and Place award winners are not eligible for class awards in the same match. Such class awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual or team.

**Directions:** Best routes to QHR&G Club can be found on Mapquest. Exit 79 off of I-395 and then Rte 163 is a direct approach for those arriving from the New Haven area. From Hartford, Rte 2 is the best road, exit onto Rte 163 South. From the Middletown area Rte 9 south then Rte 82 is the quickest and most scenic path. If you have the time, cross the Connecticut River on the Chester Ferry for a wonderful water view. If you need more details please contact the match director.
