Directions:	From the South: Take Rt. 128 or 495 to Rt. 3 North. Cross into New Hampshire. Rt. 3 becomes the Everett Turnpike.
	From the West: Take Rt. 101 to Rt. 101A East. Turn onto the Everett Turnpike South.
	From the Everett Turnpike: Take Exit 2 off the Everett Tpk.and follow the signs towards Hudson going over the Merrimack River. After crossing the Merrimack stay in the right lane and turn onto Rt. 3A South (Sam's Club on right and Wal-Mart on left). At 3 rd set of lights stay straight (right lane) to continue on Rt. 3A. Go about about 1½ miles to next lights. (Watch for HFGC sign.) Turn left at lights onto Pine Rd. Club is ¼ mile on left. Use glass door entrance on left of building.
Rules:	 NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern. Use of OBI/ECI is mandatory. Ear protection is mandatory. Eye protection is strongly recommended.
Match Open To:	 Open to all Juniors (rule 2.3) Only Juniors who reside in New Hampshire may earn the State Champion title.
Match Entry Fees:	 Match entry fee is \$20.00 in total for each individual entry. This includes: NRA registration fee of \$5.50 State registration fee of \$3.00 Team entry is \$9.00 for the entire team

Entries:	Call the contact person on the first page to reserve an entry. Entries close Saturday, 4/11.
Post Entries	Post Entries will be accepted until the relay is called to the firing line. A Post Entry fee of \$3.00 will be added.
Entry Limit:	The match is limited to 32 competitors. Eight per relay maximum.
Relays:	Relay 1: Friday, 4/17 - 6:30 PM Relay 2: Sunday, 4/19 - 9:00 AM Relay 3: Sunday, 4/19 - 11:45 AM Relay 4: Sunday, 4/19 - 2:30 PM (only if needed)
Categories:	Junior, Intermediate Junior, Sub Junior.
Teams:	An unfired <u>three person team match is available</u> . Pickup teams are allowed. A team may register until the relay for any one team member is called to the firing line. No team may be created that includes a competitor who has already fired.
Awards:	 Awards available for Match Champion plus 1st place in J, IJ and SJ. Category awards require two or more competitors. 2nd place award if six or more in a category. 3rd place if 11, etc. A Team award is available if two or more teams enter.
Course of Fire:	 All shots fired on A-36 targets in the following order: 20 shots Prone – 20 minutes 20 shots Standing – 40 minutes 20 shots Kneeling – 30 minutes (see special instructions regarding target changes below)
Equipment:	Any .22 caliber rimfire rifle conforming to NRA rule 3.2.Metallic sights only conforming to NRA rule 3.7a.
Target Changes:	The Hudson F&G Club indoor range traps allow only one target to be posted at a time. Shooters will be allowed two minutes to change targets and a one minute preparation period between targets when no position change is needed.
	When a position change is needed, competitors will be allowed two minutes to change targets and then ten minutes for their combined equipment changeover and preparation period.
