<u>Sponsoring Organization</u> – The New York State Rifle and Pistol Association (NYSRPA).

<u>Eligibility</u> - Open to any New York State resident who is currently a member of the NYSRPA. Competitors will compete in either an open or a scholastic category. The scholastic category is open to competitors younger than 21 years of age.

# MATCH PROGRAM

Relay Capacity -- 16 Competitors.

Rifle Requirements –Any smallbore rifle meeting USAS rule 7.4.2; any air rifle meeting USAS rule 7.4.3.5

Sights - Metallic sights (iron sights) only.

Match Times -- 8:30 am and 1:00 pm on the scheduled dates.

Competitors are requested to arrive in sufficient time (30-45 minutes) before their scheduled relay.

<u>Coaching</u> – prohibited during any competition.

<u>Challenges</u> -- A challenge fee of \$1.00 per match must be paid when a scoring protest is submitted. If the protest is lost, the fee will remain with the chief statistician.

<u>Ties</u>—Ties between competitors having the same match score will be broken in favor of the competitor having the **greater number of center shots**.

<u>Awards</u> – Gold, silver and bronze medallions will be awarded to top competitors in the Scholastic and Open 120-shot prone, 3-position, and air rifle matches. Awards will be provided for each event as follows:

<u>Entries</u> – Entries will be accepted up to range capacity on a first come first serve basis Competitors traveling less than a 100 miles from the Iroquois range will be placed on the first relay of each day. Competitors traveling 100 miles or more will be placed on the second relay unless the early relay is requested.

# 2009 NEW YORK STATE RIFLE & PISTOL ASSN. INTERNATIONAL RIFLE SHOOTING FESTIVAL

#### Purpose

The purpose of this document is to set forth the conditions for the New York State International Rifle Shooting Festival. The Festival shooting matches will continue the international style rifle matches that have been an integral part of the Empire State Games. The match program entry form for the rifle Festival is attached.

#### Sponsorship and Eligibility

The Festival matches are sponsored by the New York State Rifle and Pistol Association which also provides insurance coverage for the event venues. Since the NYSRPA will be providing the necessary insurance coverage, participants **must be members in good standing in the NYSRPA**. NYSRPA membership must in force prior to participating in the Festival events.

#### **Competitor Categories**

Rifle competition will be divided into scholastic and open categories. Scholastic competitors are limited to those who have not reached their 21st birthday.

#### **Shooting Venues**

The rifle events will be held on July 18 and July 19 at the outdoor range of the Iroquois Rod and Gun Club outside of Rotterdam. This time frame will permit Camp Perry rifle competitors to participate in one match before leaving for the Camp Perry matches.

International pistol matches will be fired on the weekend of July 25 and 26 at the Duchess County Pistol Association at Wappinger Falls. This time frame is after the Camp Perry pistol competitions, and pistol competitors will be able to participate in the Festival pistol events. The match program for the pistol events can be obtained by contacting the match director for the international pistol events, Pat Zidek, at paz418@gmail.com.

#### **Tryouts**

There will be no tryouts for participation in the Festival matches. Participants must compete in two separate smallbore rifle matches to be eligible for awards. Air rifle competitions will be a single 60-shot match.

#### Rifle Match Format

The rifle competitions available for the Festival will be a 120-shot prone match, a 120-shot 3-position and a 60-shot air rifle event for open and scholastics competitors.

Two relays will be conducted on each day of the Festival. The format for each relay will be a 60-shot prone match, a 20-shot standing match and a 20-shot kneeling match.

For those competing for 3-position awards the score of the first 20 shots of the prone match will be used as the prone score for the 3-position match.

Competitors can elect to fire the second match of their competition on the same day or on the following day of the Festival.

Competitors traveling less than a 100 miles from the Iroquois range will be placed on the first relay of each day. Competitors traveling 100 miles or more will be placed on the second relay unless the early relay is requested.

#### <u>Awards</u>

Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the top three scholastic and open competitors in the prone, 3-position, and air rifle events. Qualifying scores for awards will be based on the sum of two fired matches in the prone and 3-position competitions. Additional awards may be awarded depending on the number of participants in the event.

Open and scholastic air rifle category awards will be based on the top 3 category scores in the 60-shot air rifle competitions.

#### **Entry Fees**

Total competitor fee for the rifle Festival is \$25 which covers an entry fee and two relays of competition. Match fee for the air rifle competition is \$5.

Participation in additional relays after completion of their two competition matches for practice purposes may be permitted if firing points are available. The charge for such practice matches is \$5.
