## 2010 Connecticut State USA Shooting Junior Olympic Air Rifle and Smallbore Rifle Championship

State USA Shooting Junior Olympic Championships (JOSCs) are state competitions that allow juniors to try to qualify for an invitation to the National USA Shooting Junior Olympic Championships (NJOSC).

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This competition is open to all competitors born in **1990** or later. All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting. Applications will be available to join.
- **RESIDENCE:** Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Non-residents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so.
- **STATE RESIDENT QUALIFIERS:** USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships Championships (NJOSC) for the high scoring male and high scoring female resident from each State JOSC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and/or military competitors are eligible for the state resident champion awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.
- **ENTRY**: Shooters <u>may not compete in more than one</u> state JOSC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC will be allowed to enter the automatic/at-large division in another state. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare that they are shooting for an at-large/automatic invitation.
  - Residents may choose to enter the Automatic/At-large category instead of the Resident Qualifier category if they are confident they can shoot above the automatic score and secure an invitation. This would allow another competitor to receive the State Qualifier invitation.
  - A. **Resident Qualifier** Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSC.
  - B. Automatic/At Large Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSC.
- **TEAMS:** Teams will consist of three firing members.
- CATEGORIES:The following categories will be used for individual and team competition:CLASSIFICATION:(Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2009.)Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 1980--1992Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 1993--1995Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 1996 or later.
- **RULES:** Current USA Shooting Rules will govern.

- **FIREARMS:** Air Rifle .177 caliber air rifle (spring piston , pneumatic, CO2 or compressed air) and Smallbore Rifle .22 caliber smallbore rifle

TARGETS:	Air Rifle – AR-5/1; and, Smallbore Rifle - USAS 50			
COACHING:	Coaching will not be permitted.			
SCORING PROTESTS	A scoring protest of \$1.00 for competitor's own target(s); \$3.00 for another competitor's target(s).			
TIES:	All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules.			
<b>PARTICIPATION PINS:</b> A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.				
AWARDS:	USA Shooting Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallions will be awarded to the top three resident individuals in each of the two disciplines (Air & Smallbore Rifle). Individual sets will be awarded to females and males.			
SCORE SHEETS:	Special score sheets must be used for all State JOSCs. YOUR USAS MEMBERSHIP NUMBER AND THE LAST FOUR NUMBERS OF YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ARE MANDATORY. They are to be filled in completely and signed by the competitor to be considered for invitation to the National JOSC. <u>LEGIBLE</u> handwriting is required. If we cannot read your handwriting you may not get your invitation.			
ENTRIES:	Entries should be made using the entry form enclosed with this program. A separate entry form must be completed for each event (so if you are shooting smallbore rifle and air rifle, you need to complete two entry forms—one for smallbore rifle and one for air rifle). Mail entry and remittance to Deb Lyman, 30 Maple Avenue, Meriden, CT, 06450. Make checks payable to Blue Trail Range. Squadding will be confirmed upon receipt of entry and remittance if received prior to December 8.			
ENTRY FEES:	USA Shooting Registration Fee: \$8.00 per event. Individual Entry Fee: \$5 per event. Range Fee: \$5 per event. <b>Membership in USA Shooting is mandatory for this match.</b> See the attached membership application (complete and bring with you to the match) or go on-line at <u>www.usashooting.org</u> and sign-up.
