DISTANCE FIRED: Fifty (50) feet.

RIFLE: .22 caliber Rifle NRA Rule 3.2

SIGHTS: any sights NRA Rule 3.7C

TARGETS: USA/NRA 50

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all individuals, please present classification card at match.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification will be used. Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman

ENTRIES: Limited to first 24 people who register. Preference given to RI residents that register by the March 1st. Post entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range. Entries received by the Monday prior to the match are guaranteed a firing point if not in excess of 24. Range capacity is 24 competitors. SR-1 cards will be filled out at the match.

FEES: Registration fee \$20.00

A \$5.00 discount for individuals will be offered upon presentation of a RI State Association membership card. Non-residents showing membership in their state association will be granted the \$5.00 discount.

Challenge fee \$2.00

TIME LIMITS: PRONE 40 shots 2 stages, each stage - 20 shots in 20 minutes
STANDING 40 shots 2 stages, each stage - 20 shots in 40 minutes
KNEELING 40 shots 2 stages, each stage - 20 shots in 30 minutes
Time left from one stage (position) cannot be used in the next stage (position).

RELAYS: Saturday, 9 AM & 1 PM
Sunday, 9 AM & 1 PM

AWARDS: Overall winner (if non-resident): trophy
RI State Champion: trophy
George S. Melcher trophy
The George S. Melcher trophy is awarded to the competitor with the highest score who either resides in Rhode Island or is a regular participant in the RI Smallbore Rifle League (meets requirements for league awards). This is a revolving trophy in memory of George S. Melcher.
Award for winner in each classification. Addition award for each five (5) competitors in a class after 10. If there are fewer than five (5) entries in a class, they will be combined with the next higher class.
