Range Location: The Wa-Ke'-De Rifle Range is located two miles east of Bristol, Indiana on State Road 120. The nearest large city is Elkhart about seven miles. Exit the Indiana Toll Road at the Bristol Exit and proceed south on Indiana 15 for approximately two miles to Route 120. Turn left for approximately another two miles. Range is on north side of road and is clearly marked. The outdoor range has **100** covered and paved firing points facing north. Flush toilets, washrooms and showers are available. Camping is allowed, there are electrical hookups. Other nearby campgrounds are Bonneyville Mill and Eby's Pines. Port Clinton is two and one-half hours away on the toll road (I-80/90) that runs across our property **GPS:** Our neighbor's address on the South side of road is: 16060 Hwy 120, Bristol.

Local Attractions: Shipshewana and Middlebury are within 15 minutes of the range.

Rules: NRA Rules will govern. Rifle, Rule 3.2, Challenges, Rule 16.1 (fee \$2.00 to challenge your own score, \$3.00 to challenge another competitor's score). NRA Classification will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Entry Limits: 30 shooters on one relay or 60 shooters on two relays.

Fees: A package fee of \$60.00 will cover all fired matches, aggregates, and registration fees. Juniors may shoot at \$15.00 per day.

Awards: We will provide One Award for every four Competitors in a Class. We expect a 45-50% return for prizes from the entry fees. Juniors do not receive cash awards.

Target Clips: Competitors must supply their own clips.

Targets: Targets used will be: A-23 50 yd, A-27 50m Reduced & A-25 100 Yd. Competitors will hang their own targets and are responsible for correctly positioning backers.

Eligibility: Open to all. In order to set a National Record, a competitor must be a member of the National Rifle Association.

Practice: The range will be open Wednesday afternoon for camping set-up and practice. In 2010, the National Metric Prone matches will be finishing up on Wednesday and practice cannot begin until the NRA staff clears the range.

Squadding: Shooters will fire from one firing point for both days. We will be using the center of the line and there is no advantage of one point over the other.

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA in a NRA Regional Tournament.

Class and Categories: Class and category will be determined by the number of entries in each. Classes/categories that have enough entries to stand alone, will. Classes/categories with insufficient entries will be combined for awards.

Sticker Match: A sticker match is run on Thursday, it is a free match and the rules will be explained prior to competition.
