BASIC INFORMATION

Performance standard scores can be established at this match.

All U.S. participants must be individual members of USA Shooting (USAS).

It is imperative to submit your entry as early as possible. **Online entry is encouraged**.

The United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) may conduct testing for banned substances.

Competitors or their physicians may address questions concerning medication to the USADA Drug Hotline at 1-800-233-0393.

Remember that even over-the-counter medications can contain a banned substance. Always check first with your doctor and the Drug Hotline before taking any medication prior to competition.

Open finals will be conducted at the end of each course of fire in all events. Junior finals will not take place at this event.

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM SELECTION

The 2010 Spring Selection Match will be a US <u>Open</u> Team Tryout for the 2010 World Shooting Championships in Munich Germany. FOREIGN COMPETITORS

This match is a US team trial and priority will go to US citizens. Foreigners interested in competing in this competition should fill out the entry form and mail along with a copy of their passport (picture page). Please do not mail entry fees for this match, payment in US dollars will be accepted onsite.

To obtain a Firearms permit for the United States, foreign competitors may contact the United States Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (BATFE) to find out about the procedures for entering the United States with a firearm or download the BATFE form from www.usashooting.org and fax it to our office ATTN: Lones Wigger at 719-866-4884 for processing.

RULES

- 1. This competition is governed by current USA Shooting Rules and any Match Director's bulletins posted for this competition. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the USA Shooting Rules.
- 2. For this match we will implement USAS Rule 8.7.4.5.3.1A, allowing up to 2 allowable malfunctions per 30 shot stage of 25m events.

CODE OF CONDUCT

By registering for this competition you are agreeing to abide by the USA Shooting Code of Conduct both on and off the range complex for the duration of the event. As a participant, you are representing our sport and organization. Providing an example of good conduct, appearance and sportsmanship is paramount. The Code of Conduct is available in the Competition Entry Office and on the USAS website.

REGISTRATION

- 1. All competitors must be individual USA Shooting members and provide their USA Shooting membership number. Non US citizens must be members of their respective federations.
- 2. Check-in for all events will be done at the Entry Office (located in the 50m range) not later than noon the day prior to the first match day in which the athlete competes.
- 3. If there are any spots available for a particular event, entry for those spots for people not previously entered will stop at noon on the official training day.
- 4. It is recommended that all competitors have a PTO score on file with USA Shooting to compete in this match, however it is not necessary. Alternate evidence of international event operations knowledge and proficiency will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Complete the official entry form located on our membership database which can be found at <u>usashooting.org</u>. You will receive a registration confirmation number as soon as you have completed the application process. You can also fill out the below form and mail it in with your entry fee and waiver to:

CANCELLATIONS / REFUNDS

- 2. Refunds will not be given after May 1, 2010.
- 3. Proof of Military deployment will receive a full refund.

AWARDS

Only U.S. citizens are eligible for finals and selection to any US Shooting Team.

Non-U.S. citizens may compete but are not eligible for finals or selection to any US Shooting Team and therefore are not eligible for awards for this competition.

The open men's and women's champion, second place and third place finishers will receive awards. For rifle & pistol events, awards will be based on the aggregate of the 3 match courses plus the top 2 finals scores.
