The Black Hawk Open is a series of Smallbore Rifle Matches sponsored by the Black Hawk Rifle Club and Hosted by the Asheville Rifle & Pistol Club at their range in Asheville, North Carolina. The matches are open to all Black Hawk members, members of the National Rifle Association of America and other interested smallbore shooters.

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The entrance is located on NC 191 about 1/2 mile south of the Blue Ridge Parkway bridge and about 7 miles south of West Asheville.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Competitors will make their own reservations and WE ADVISE TO MAKE THEM EARLY. Motels 2 miles north of range: Comfort Suites, 890 Brevard Rd. (828-665-4000); Country Inn & Suites, (828-670-9000); Hampton Inn, 1-26 and NC 191 (828-667-2022). Holiday Inn Express Hotel and Suites (828-665-6519), and Wingate Inn (828-665-4242). Also, Days Inn, 1-26 and Airport, about 5 miles south of the range (828-684-2281); and Holiday Inn Airport (828-684-1213). Camping space is available at the range, which will be open on Thursday. NO HOOKUPS. The Quality Inn and Suites South, contact Randy Smith @ 828-771-2284. This motel is located at 1 Skyline Inn Drive, Arden, NC, Telephone 828-684-6688. It is approximately 2 miles south of the range and 3 miles north of the Asheville Airport. There is a complimentary continental breakfast provided.

ANY SIGHT 3200: Senior shooters, or others, may shoot any sights both days and thus compete in a separate any sight group. Awards will be calculated as per awards formula. A minimum of three competitors is required and such a group is not eligible for any of the regular tournament placings on Saturday or in the Grand Aggregate except within their group.

EATS: Sandwiches and refreshments will be available at the range. The Black Hawk Rifle Club's Annual Banquet will be held at the conclusion of firing on Saturday and will consist of a gourmet buffet. All competitors are invited at cost (BH members \$10, non BH members \$25).

FRIDAY - 28 MAY 2010: This will be a practice day. The Asheville Rifle and Pistol Club Range will be open beginning at 1:00p.m. And will remain open until approximately 5:30p.m.

SATURDAY - 29 MAY 2010: The metallic sight 1600 aggregate (Match #501) of the Conventional Prone 3200 Championship (Match #50) will be fired beginning at 9:00a.m. It will consist of 40 shots prone fired at 50 yards of the A-23 target (Match #51), 40 shots prone fired at 50 yards on the A-27 target. (50 meters reduced to 50 yards) (Match #52), 40 shots prone, a Dewar match, with 20 shots at 50 yards on the A-23 target and 20 shots

fired at 100 yards, A-25 target, (Match #53). A 100-yard match consisting of 40 shots prone fired on the A-25 target. (Match #54).

SUNDAY - 30 MAY 2010: The any sight 1600 aggregate (Match #502) of the Conventional Prone 3200 Championship (Match #50) will be fired beginning at 9:00a.m. It will consist of 40 shots prone fired at 50 yards on the A-23 target (Match #55), 40 shots prone fired at 50 yards on the A-27 target (50 meters reduced to 50 yards-Match #56), 40 shots prone a Dewar match, with 20 shots at 50 yards on the A-23 target and 20 shots fired at 100 yards, A-25 target, (Match #57). A 100-yard match consisting of 40 shots prone fired on the A-25 target (Match #58).

MEMORIAL DAY MATCHES: Two matches will be conducted on Memorial Day Monday, May 29. An NRA English Match and NRA 3-Position match. Both metallic sights. A-51 target. Course of fire will include a 60 shot prone match followed by 40 shots standing and 40 shots kneeling. Competitors may enter the English match only.

AWARDS SCHEDULE: A "sliding scale" awards schedule (award points and/or cash) will be used which will make an equitable distribution of awards based on the number of entries in each class/category. This awards schedule will be approximately 60% of total receipts minus necessary expenses (NRA registration fee, cost of targets, etc.). Competitors and others are invited to sponsor any particular match (es) or any special or fun award; such aggrandizement or largess will bear the name of the donor. A minimum of three entries is required to form a class.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors.

RULES: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will prevail. Rules 3.2, 2.10 thru 2.20 used.

A registration form is required to compete in these matches. Also the Asheville Rifle & Pistol Club requires a hold harmless form. Entries post marked after May 15th is subject to a \$5.00 late registration fee. Entries cancelled within one week of the event will forfeit their entry fee.

SCORING OF CHALLENGED SHOTS AND SHOTS OF QUESTIONABLE VALUE:

In this tournament, the plug type scoring gauge will be restricted to use by range operating personnel who may include the range officers, statistical director, executive officer, and the three members of the jury who will be picked prior to firing time.

TARGETS: Official NRA targets will be used. Shooters will mark and hang their own targets. CLIPS ARE REQUIRED. The fully allowed time will be completed for each stage of fire or as determined by the Match Director.

General Release and Liability Waiver

This document may have legal consequences: you are encouraged to read it carefully.

WHEREAS, ASHEVILLE RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB, a North Carolina non-profit membership organization (ARPC) owns and provides to its members and guests a certain property to be used as a membership only recreational and target shooting range; and

WHEREAS, the said ARPC has established and provides for a regular schedule of dates and times when the said property may be used for the designated purposes, and further, provides the services of volunteer members as range safety personnel in order to maintain a well regulated schedule of access and use of the facility; and

WHEREAS, the said ARPC has established a set of standard operating procedures and other rules and regulations in order to provide a framework for the safe operation of the facility as a target shooting range, which has been provided to each member of the Club and by which each member is responsible for their conduct and the conduct of their guests while on range property;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties hereto, each signatory set forth below agrees that:

- 1) He/she assumes sole responsibility for:
 - a) their actions and the actions of those under their control and supervision in the use of fireanns, vehicles and/or any other personal property while on the Club premises, and all such actions or conduct shall not be attributable in any manner to ARPC, its agents or assigns; -
 - b) any l6ss or injury w1Uch maybe directly or indirectly attributable to their acts while on Club property; and agrees to indemnify the said ARPC for any monetary damages which may be assessed against it as a result of said actions or activities.
- 2) Each member/guest is familiar with and knowledgeable concerning any and all personal property used on the property. Further, each member/guest affirms that he/she will comply immediately with instruction from range safety personnel present on the facility. Further, each member affirms that he/she will be responsible for the actions oftheir guest(s) while on the property.
- 3) The member/guest hereby releases forever the said ARPC, its officers, directors and range safety personnel, jointly and severally, of any liability for the actions of the member/guest in their use of the facility, and waives any claim the member/guest believes he/she now has or hereafter may acquire against the said ARPC, its successors and/or assigns.
- 4) If the guest is a minor, or under any disability which prevents the said guest from acting in their own interests, then their participation in any activity while on the premises shall be under the supervision of a parent or other legally designated guardian; or if the activity is under the sponsorship of a Club or other officially sanctioned youth or disability program, then such participation shall be under the supervision of a designated supervisor of such program or activity, which shall be solely responsible for their action.
- 5) ARPC reserves the right to refuse any person the use of the Club property in accordance with the following polices:
 - a) Any guest may be refused permission to use the property for any reason or for no reason, in the sale discretion of the ARPC, its officers, directors or in the judgment of any range safety personnel present on the facility.
 - b) Members of the Club are bound by the bylaws, standard operation procedures, other roles and regulations and any infractions will be handled as provided therein.
- 6) The member/guest acknowledges that he/she has read and understands the foregoing, and executes this release and waiver of his /her own free will and not under any form of coercion or duress; a copy of the form has been received by the member/guest.
