**Directions to Range:** Take I-495 to Route 2 west. Immediately take exit 39. Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Taylor St. Take your first left onto Porter Rd. and follow it to the end. At the end of Porter Rd., turn left onto Whitcomb Ave. (Whitcomb Ave. becomes Littleton County Road). After 1.3 miles, look for a driveway on the left side (small sign, dirt road, easy to miss). Gate should be open on match day. If you reach Old Schoolhouse Rd. or Cleaves Hill Rd., you've gone too far.

   Competitors must leave line to talk to coach.

**General Information:** H.S.C. range safety rules will be enforced (eye and ear protection required). These are HSC's rules not the Match Directors rules ;)

Please arrive at least 45 minutes before relay start time.

H.S.C can provide 8 shooting mats and/or spotting scopes if any competitor or coach needs them.
