Directions

From the Everett Turnpike:

Take Exit 2 off the Everett Tpk. and follow the signs towards Hudson going over the Merrimack River. After crossing the Merrimack stay in the right lane and turn onto Rt. 3A South (Sam's Club on right and Wal-Mart on left). At 3rd set of lights stay straight (right lane) to continue on Rt. 3A.

Go about about 1½ miles to next lights. (Watch for HFGC sign.) Turn left at lights onto Pine Rd. Club is ¼ mile on left. Use the glass door entrance on the left.

Rules

- NRA National Junior and Open Indoor Sectional rules will govern.
- Use of a Clear Bore Indicator is mandatory.
- Ear protection is strongly recommended.
- Eye protection is strongly recommended.

Match Entry Fees

Junior Sectional:

\$20.00 for each individual Junior competitor.

This includes:

- Entry and range fee of \$11.50.
- NRA registration fee of \$8.50 (includes entry of the individual in the NRA National Indoor Rifle Championship).

Team entry is \$12.00 for the entire 4 person Junior team (includes entry of the team in the NRA National Indoor Rifle Championship).

Open Sectional:

\$25.00 for each individual Open Competitor. This includes:

- Entry and range fee of \$16.50.
- NRA registration fee of \$8.50 (includes entry of the individual in the NRA National Indoor Rifle Championship).

Team entry is \$12.00 for the entire 3 person Open team (includes entry of the team in the NRA National Indoor Rifle Championship).

Entries

Contact the person above to reserve an entry. Entries close Saturday, 2/26.

Post Entries

Post Entries will be accepted until the relay is called to the firing line. A Post Entry fee of \$3.00 will be added.

Entry Limit

The match is limited to 21 competitors. Seven per relay maximum.

Relays

Relays may be mixed with both Junior and Open sectional competitors. Declare which sectional you are competing in when you contact the Match Director to reserve your entry.

Relay 1: Friday, 3/04 - 6:30 PM
Relay 2: Saturday, 3/05 - 9:00 AM
Relay 3: Saturday, 3/05 - 11:30 AM

(an additional Saturday relay may be added with a minimum of 4 entries and only if earlier relays fill)

Awards

Sectional Medallions (and award points for Open competitors) will be awarded based on the number of competitors.

- Gold Sectional Champion Medallion (and 15 award points) if 5 or more.
- Silver Medallion (and 10 award points) if 10 or more.
- Bronze Medallion (and 5 award points) if 15 or more.

Additional Junior category and Open class awards will be available based on the number of competitors.
