SAFETY: Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all competitors while on the

firing line. The use of open chamber indicators is mandatory.

COURSE OF FIRE: Match 1: 40 Shots Prone fired in two 20 shot stages

Match 2: 40 Shots Offhand fired in two 20 shot stages Match 3: 40 Shots Kneeling fired in two 20 shot stages

Match 4: Sectional Intl. Smallbore Rifle Individual Championship

Match 5: Sectional Intl. Smallbore Rifle Team Championship (Unfired team match with scores taken from Match 4)
