Location:	Reading Rifle and Revolver Club, Haverhill St., Reading MA
Eligibility:	Firing Individual Juniors and Junior Teams will be eligible for an invite from the CMP to the 3p air finals. Invites are determined by the CMP per State. Precision and Sporter Teams and Individual are eligible.
Teams:	Teams will consist of 4 Firing Junior Members in either precision or sporter
Rules:	National Standard three-Position Air Rifle rules will apply
Course of Fire:	Air Rifle : 3 x 20, 20 prone, 20 off-hand, 20 kneeling Finals 10 shots, fired and scored individually
Time limits:	Prep Time : 10 minutes 20 shots prone: 30 minutes Change over time: 15 minutes 20 shots standing: 40 minutes Change over time: 15 minutes 20 shots kneeling: 30 minutes
Rifle:	Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6
Sights:	Metallic sights only; Rule 4.2.5
Targets:	Air Rifle - AR 5/10 (10 record bulls)
Distance:	Air Rifle – Ten (10) meters (approx. 33 feet)
Coaching:	Coaching will not be permitted.
Protests:	A scoring protest of \$1.00 will be charged, if the protest is won the \$1.00 will be returned to the challenger. If the challenge is lost, the \$1.00 is not returned.
Awards:	Gold, Silver and Bronze Pins to the 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place winners Precision 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place winners in Sporter. Gold Silver and Bronze Pins to the top – J1,J2,J3 competitors if there is 5 or more in each class for both sporter and precision. If not they will be added to the next higher class. Only one award is given to an individual competitor. Teams: 1 <sup>st</sup> (4 teams registered), 2 <sup>nd</sup> ( 5 teams registered) 3 <sup>rd</sup> place (6 teams registered)
Entry Fees:	Air Rifle Match - \$20.00                      Team Entry fee ...\$10 per team
Range Capacity:	The capacity of each relay is fourteen (14) competitors
Directions:	<b>From Boston--</b> Take I-93N to Exit 37A. Merge onto I-95 N towards Peabody. Take I-95 exit 40 towards Wakefield Ctr/North Reading. Coming off of the ramp, go around the rotary and go back under 128, staying in the right lane. Haverhill St. is the first street on the right (National Guard Base on your right). Continue on Haverhill for approx. one mile. On your right will be a sign for Burlington Ice Arena and Reading Rifle & Revolver.
