3-Position Small-bore Rifle

20 minutes to shoot 20 shots prone
5 min change over period, plus a 3 min prep
40 minutes to shoot 20 shots offhand
5 min change over period, plus a 3 min prep
30 minutes to shoot 20 shots kneeling
Air Rifle – International
60 shots for men 120 minutes, 40 shots for women 90 minutes

NO coaching is allowed ----Competitors ONLY will be allowed to review targets during the challenge period.

Awards will be given to the top three overall winners in both air and .22 (Adults and Juniors combined) and the top competitor in each category of Junior, Intermediate Junior or Sub-junior in small-bore. If there are less than 5 competitors in a category they will be combined with the next highest category for awards. Only one award will be given to a competitor.
