ENTRY LIMIT Entries are limited to 90 competitors. Entries received beyond range capacity will be notified. NOTE: Post entries will be accepted up to range capacity (an additional \$5.00 post entry charge will be assessed after 15 April 2010). Entries who fail to compete (No shows) without acceptable cause will be charged the full match fee.

NOTE: Teams who register in advance and fail to appear without at least 5 days advanced notice will be charged the tournament fee.

<u>CHALLENGES</u> The challenge fee will be \$1.00 per match (\$3.00 to challenge another competitor's targets). The use of plug type scoring gauge will be restricted to use by the, Executive Officer, scoring personnel, and the three members of the jury.

<u>TARGETS</u> Official NRA targets (A-23) will be used. Shooters will mark and hang their own targets. Metal clips are required by each competitor to hang their own targets.

ACCOMODATIONS Several fine motels are in the Fairfax, VA area. Competitors need to make their own reservations.

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE The NRA Range is located in the NRA Headquarters parking lot, lower level. The headquarters is at the intersection of Interstate 66 and Highway 50. Coming south on Highway 50, turn left at the first stop light onto Waples Mill Road and drive about 2/10 of a mile to the headquarters located on your right.

MATCH SCHEDULE

Match 1 - 40 shots prone

Match 2 – 40 shots standing

Match 3 – 40 shots kneeling

Match 4 – aggregates of matches 1, 2, and 3

Match 5 – Team Match (Two Person Paper Teams)

AWARDS SCHEDULE

Awards schedule will be posted on the Match Directors Bulletin Board. Awards are dependent on the numbers of entries -- award notification will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board. Junior Competitors will be awarded NRA AWARD POINTS and if a junior shooter declines NRA Award Point then the shooter must notify the statistical office when registering.

A minimum of five entrees is required to form a class. Second place awards will be presented if there are SIX or more entries in a class. Third place awards will be presented if there are 12 or more entries in a class.

An individual or team winning a "place" award will not be entitled to a class award in the same match. Such class awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual or team.

RELAY DRAWINGS

Prizes will be draw for competitors on each relay. All shooters, including juniors, are eligible for these prizes. These prizes do not violate NCAA Rules as they are won by chance and not for performance.
