- Location:** RBGC is approximately 60 road miles north of downtown Atlanta in the southwest corner of Dawson County and 15 miles west of Dawsonville, GA. For driving directions to the club, please refer to the interactive map on our web site at [www.rbgc.org](http://www.rbgc.org). From the home page click on "Club Information" and then click on "Get Directions To RBGC".
- Facilities:** Multi-purpose Range 2 (MP2), the competition venue, has 44 paved and covered firing points.  
**Please Note** - All competitors must sign an RBGC liability release *before* competing or unloading equipment. Liability releases for junior competitors must be signed by an adult guardian. Also, please remember that RBGC non-member guests are limited to use of the MP2 range only during competition and while a member of the match staff is present. Club rules require that all non-member guests be signed-in and accompanied by an RBGC member at all times while shooting on any RBGC range except when the guest is a registered competitor shooting on the match venue and while the match staff is present. Accordingly, should you need to use MP2 or any other range or club facility when the match staff is not present, you may only do so as a guest of and when accompanied by an RBGC member. Please direct any questions about these requirements to Tommy Steadman, the match staff, the RBGC Club Manager or RBGC Chief Range Officer.
- Food & Beverage:** There are no snack or restaurant facilities at RBGC or nearby and we recommend that you bring lunch, drinks, and snacks you will require until at least mid-afternoon.
- Eligibility:** Open to all competitors. Membership in River Bend Gun Club or the NRA is not required.
- Rules:** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern. The .22 Caliber Rimfire Rifle as defined in NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules 3.2 (Any Rifle) applies. Per Rule 3.21, the requirement for a smallbore empty chamber indicator (ECI) to indicate that the chamber is empty will be strictly enforced.
- Sights:** Any sight may be used without restriction as to material or construction.
- Classification:** The NRA classification system will be used. Competitors without an NRA classification will fire in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 (assigned classification) or Rule 19.2 (temporary classification) may be used.
- Entry Fee:** The entry fee for all competitors is \$20.00 and includes a \$4.50 NRA Registration Fee.
- Entries Limited:** Entries are limited to 44 individual competitors.
- Targets:** Official NRA Conventional targets will be used: Target A-23/5 at 50 yards, target A-25 at 100 yards, and target A-26 at 50 meters.  
Targets and target backers will be provided by the sponsor but competitors will mark and hang their own targets before each match stage when directed to do so by the Chief Range Officer. Target clips are required and must be furnished by each competitor.  
As provided by Rule 10.5, competitors will act as scorers when requested to do so by the Match Director or Chief Range Officer, except that no competitor will score his or her own target. Competitor-scored targets will be verified by the Statistical Office.

Course of Fire: 40 shots at 50 meters

Course of Fire: 20 shots at 50 yards and 20 shots at 100 yards  
Targets A-23/5, A-25
- Match No. 4     100 Yard - Any Sight Match  
Course of Fire: 40 shots at 100 yards  
Target A-25
- Match No. 5     1600 Aggregate  
Aggregate score from matches 1, 2, 3, and 4

**Time of Firing:** Firing commences at 9:00 AM except the March 19 tournament which begins at 10:00 AM.

**Challenges:** Challenges and protests will be addressed as described in Rule 16. A \$1 challenge fee will be charged for each challenge of a competitor's own target and \$2 fee for challenge of other competitors' targets. Challenge fees will be collected by the match director or statistical office before making the first recheck. Challenge fees will be returned if the challenge is sustained at any point along the line of rechecks. Challenges for matches 1 and 3 may be made until the preliminary results of the next number match is posted. The challenge period for matches 3 and 4 ends when the awards presentation begins.

Scoring Of Challenged Shots And Shots Of Questionable Value: The plug type scoring gauge will be restricted to use by match officers or other match officials.

### Schedule Of Awards:

Open and Class Winners of the 1600 aggregate match (Match No. 5) will receive an award in recognition of their achievement per the award schedule below. At the Match Director's discretion awards may consist of medals, ribbons, plaques, trophies or cash.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> place Open medal will be offered in tournaments with 15 or more total entries.

A 3<sup>rd</sup> place Open medal will be awarded in tournaments with 25 or more total entries.

A minimum of 5 entries is required to form a class.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> place Class medal will be awarded in classes with 10 or more entries in a class.

A 3<sup>rd</sup> place Class medal will be awarded in classes with 15 or more entries.

Competitors in classes with insufficient entries to meet the minimum entry criterion will be moved to a higher class (Rule 19.8.1).

Special recognition awards may be given at the discretion of the Match Director.
