Range Location:	The Michigan City Rifle Club (MCRC) is located five (5) miles east of Michigan City, IN on the north side of Hwy 20, near the intersections of US Hwys 20, 35, & I-94. If you come via the Indiana Toll Road (I-80) exit at the LaPorte interchange. Turn right (north) on Indiana 39 and go to Hwy 20. Turn west on Hwy 20 and approximately 3 miles to the range. The range has 38 covered and paved firing points facing north. Flush toilets and washrooms are available. Campsites with electricity are available, however there are NO shower facilities. Rules:	NRA Rules will govern. Rifle, Rule 3.2, Challenges, Rule 16.1 (\$1.00 challenge fee to challenge your own score, \$5.000 to challenge another competitor's score. NRA Classifications will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in Master Class.
Entry Limits:	38 competitor's, one (1) relay
Fees:	A package fee of \$35.00 will cover all fired individual fired matches, aggregates, and NRA registration fee. Juniors may fire for \$25.00 and will not be eligible for cash awards.
Team Fee:	\$20.00 per team (2-person team) Team match will be a 'Paper" Match
Awards:	NRA will provide Regional Awards 1 st Place if 5 competitors; 2 nd Place if 8 competitors, & 3 rd place if 13 competitors. NRA will provide Regional Souvenir Pins. MCRC is known for a generous award schedule. Exact award schedule will be determined on the number of shooters on a 4:1 basis. NRA will provide Camp Perry entry fee certificates (50% off). Only one award per class; must have 10 competitors in a class.
Time of Firing:	Shooting commences at 8:00AM each day (Central Standard Time)
Targets:	NRA Official Targets will be used with backers. Competitors should supply their own hanging clips A-23/5 Targets
Squadding:	All matches will be squadded on the day of the match.
Eligibility:	Open to all competitors. NRA Membership NOT required.

Declare team members prior to firing)
	Match 6: 20 shots, Prone, 50 Yards, Any Sights, A-23/5 Target Match 7: 20 shots, Standing, 50 Yards Any Sights A-23-5 Target Match 8: 20 shots, Kneeling A-23/5 Match 9: Regional Any Sight Championship (Total of Matches 6,7,&8) Match 10: Any Sight Team Match (Paper match. Declare team members before firing) Match 11: Regional Grand Aggregate Totals of Match 4 & 9
Regional Championship Grand Aggregate:	Match 11: Regional Championship Grand Aggregate NRA Regional Gold Medallion with minimum of 8 Shooters NRA Regional Silver Medallion with minimum of 10 Shooters NRA Regional Bronze Medallion with minimum of 15 Shooters NRA Certificates for 50% off of Camp Perry awarded for Class Winners. There must be 10 Shooters per class to win a certificate. Classes may be combined upward (NRA Rule 19.8) Regionals with less than 10 Shooters will not have Camp Perry Waivers.
Team Matches:	Paper match. Must declare team members prior to commencing individual matches.
FOOD:	We will have a kitchen that will serve pop, sandwiches, and snacks at the range. There are fast food restaurants within 5 or 6 miles of the range.
Range Availability:	The range will be open at approximately 1:00PM Friday 11 June 2010 for those that wish to practice. Targets will be provided.
SPECIAL CATEGORY	For any seniors that wish to fire the entire Regional utilizing ANY SIGHTS only they will be allowed to fire. Their scores will not count in the Regional Grand Aggregate Match and will not be allowed for ranking in the Metallic Sight Matches.
