Events: Saturday, September 3, 2011 (See Note)

- Match No. 1 40 shots, 50 yards, metallic sights, A23/5 target
- No. 2 40 shots, 50 yards, metallic sights, A27 target
- No. 3 Dewar Course, metallic sights, 20 shots, 50 yards, A23/5 target &
20 shots, 100 yards, A25 target
- No. 4 40 shots, 100 yards, metallic sights, A25 target

Note: If a minimum of 5 competitors elect to fire “any sights” throughout the metallic sight matches, they may compete as a separate category; however, they are not eligible for the Regional Metallic Sight Championship, or the Regional Grand Aggregate Championship

- No. 8 40 shots, 50 yards, any sights, A27 target

- No. 10 40 shots, 100 yards, any sights, A25 target

- Match No. 5 Regional Metallic Sight Championship

- Match No.11 Regional Any Sight Championship
Total of Matches 7, 8, 9, & 10
- Match No.12 Regional Championship – Grand Aggregate
Total of Matches 5 & 11

Match Conditions: All matches will be fired in 20 shot stages.
Current NRA Conventional Rules will govern.
Competitors will hang their own targets.
Bring your own clips (at least 12 recommended)
Unlimited sighters are permitted throughout all stages of all matches.

Match Conditions (continued):

Time Limits: 20 minutes per stage, including unlimited sighters.
Maximum number of competitors is 60. Relays 1 and 2 will fire alternately throughout the course of fire.

EYE and **EAR** protection are required by Fairfax Rod and Gun Club for **ALL** Competitors and personnel on the **FIRING LINE**.

ALL SHOTS MUST IMPACT INTO THE 50 YARD OR 100 YARD BERMS
EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS are required for use in this match

Entries: Advance entries are required. Before making match entry, be sure you know your NRA classification and NRA member number. Squadding priority will be given to advance paid entrants and those firing both days.

Who may compete: Any member of the NRA, or of an NRA Affiliated junior club.
Bring your classification card or temporary scorebook.

Fees: \$45.00 for all matches, \$30.00 for one day (includes NRA registration fee)
Junior Entrants: \$24.00 for both days, \$17.00 for one. Make checks payable
To: **George Harris** (checks will be held until after the match)
NOTE: Under current NCAA rules, junior competitors may receive award points, providing the dollar amount received does not exceed match expenses.

Challenges: \$1.00 per challenge on your own target(s); \$3.00 to challenge another competitor's target(s)

Awards: NRA Gold, Silver & Bronze medallions and Camp Perry certificates are provided by NRA.

NRA Award Points will be awarded based on the NRA Classification system and Regional award system. Junior competitors will receive special awards. Awards will be given for both fired and aggregate matches. All awards will be based on the number of participants. All participants will receive a Regional Tournament Pin. Shooters in the top 10% will earn a Distinguished Smallbore Prone step.

Other Information: Many good motels and restaurants are within reasonable driving distance. Fairfax Rod and Gun Club have a snack bar at the Clubhouse- open 10 AM until 5:30 P.M. Potable water is provided at the range. A "Johnny-On-The-Spot" is available at the range; however better rest rooms are available at the Clubhouse. The firing line is concrete and fully covered. A lunch service will be arranged if possible.
