Location:

RBGC is approximately 60 road miles north of downtown Atlanta in the southwest corner of Dawson County, 15 miles from Dawsonville, GA. Facilities:

The competition forum, RBGC's Multi-purpose Range No. 2 (MP2), has 40 paved and covered firing points.

RV parking is permitted at MP2 and the club also has a pleasant area designated for camping. Clean rest rooms and a limited number of RV water and electric hook-ups are also available at MP2. Modern showers are also available on the club grounds.

If you plan to park an RV, camp out or practice at River Bend Gun Club, please contact the match director or Club Manager before you unload your camping or competition equipment.

Please Note - All competitors must sign an RBGC liability release <u>before</u> practicing and/or competing. Liability releases for junior competitors must be signed by an adult guardian. Liability release forms will be available at the range. RBGC guests are limited to use of the MP2 range only during open practice or competition while a member of the match staff is present.

Lodging:

Lodging accommodations are conveniently located within a reasonable driving distance of the range in Cumming, Canton, Dawsonville and Gainesville. Please see the lodging listings on our web site at www.rbgc.org. From the home page click on "Club Information" and then click on "Nearby Motels and Restaurants".

Food & Beverage:

There are no restaurant facilities at RBGC or conveniently nearby and we recommend that you bring lunch, drinks, and a snack.

Rules:

Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern. The .22 Caliber Rimfire Rifle as defined in NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules 3.2 (Any Rifle) applies. Per Rule 3.21, the requirement for a smallbore empty chamber indicator (ECI) to indicate that the chamber is empty will be strictly enforced.

As provided in NRA rules, this is a simultaneous dual championship tournament in which a paper match Conventional State Championship will use the Regional Championship scores of Georgia residents who register to compete for the state championship to crown the 2011 NRA Smallbore Rifle Prone Conventional State Champion.

Eligibility:

The 43rd Annual Dixieland NRA Smallbore Rifle Prone Regional Championship is open to all competitors and there are membership requirements.

Teams will consist of two (2) firing members assigned by the statistical office based on each competitor's score in Match 1, Metallic Sight Dewar Match (see description of Odd Ball Team Match on page 5 of this program). Competitors must complete Match 1 to be eligible to enter the team match.

Return of Fees: Advance entry fees will be <u>fully refunded</u> to registered competitors who are unable to compete for any reason..

Return of Fees: A full refund will be given to competitors who have sent an advance entry but are unable to attend.

Squadding:

All matches, including team matches, will be squadded by the Statistical Office. Competitor squadding assignments for advance entries and post entries received by Friday, May 20 will be posted on the Statistical Office bulletin board by 8 AM on Saturday, May 21. Squadding assignments for all other entries will be made at time of registration and an updated squadding assignment sheet will be posted on the Statistical Office bulletin board as soon thereafter as is practical. Team squadding assignments will be announced on the range and posted on the Statistical Office bulletin board.

It is each competitor's and team's responsibility to verify their squadding assignment. Failure of an individual (or team member) to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

Squadding preference will be given to full program entries

Classification:

The NRA classification system will be used in all individual matches. Competitors without an NRA classification will fire in the Master Class unless Rule 19.6 (assigned classification) or Rule 19.2 (temporary classification) applies. Competitors whose NRA classification cannot be verified online may be asked to present an NRA classification card or NRA Score Record Book For Temporary Classification at time of registration.

Any Sight-Only 3200 Match No. 12:

Match No. 12: A special Any Sight-Only 3200 class is available to competitors who wish to shoot with telescopic sights both days. A special awards formula will be used for this class based on the total number of entries. A minimum of 5 entries is required to establish a class for award purposes and such a group is not eligible for any of the open tournament awards, except within their group and for the any sight portion of the match program.

Targets:

Official NRA Conventional targets will be used: A-23/5 at 50 yards, A-25 at 100 yards, and A-26 at 50 meters. Competitors will mark and hang their own targets before each match stage. Target clips are required and must be furnished by each competitor. Targets will be scored by the Statistical Office staff under the supervision of the Chief Statistical Officer. Scored targets will be available for inspection by competitors in the Statistical Office.

Challenges:

Challenges and protests will be addressed as described in Rule 16. A \$2.00 challenge fee will be charged for each challenge and collected by the Statistical Office before making the first recheck. The fee will be returned if the challenge is sustained at any point along the line of rechecks. Challenge time limits for each match will be posted on the Statistical Office bulletin board.

Scoring Of Challenged Shots And Shots Of Questionable Value: In this tournament, the plug type scoring gauge will be restricted to use by range operating personnel including range officers, chief statistical officer, and one or more of the three members of the jury who will be selected prior to firing time. Competitors may not use a scoring plug under any circumstance.

Schedule Of Awards:

Awards Furnished By The National Rifle Association:

Individual Regional 3200 Championship Awards - Match No. 11, 3200 Grand Aggregate

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion (Requires a minimum of 5 competitors)

2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion (requires minimum 10 competitors)

3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (requires minimum 15 competitors)

Individual Regional Class Awards – NRA medal for the winner of each class having 5 or more entries -- Master, Expert, Sharpshooter and Marksman.

Team Regional Championship Award – Match No. 12, 2-Man Team Championship – An NRA team medal will be awarded to each member of the winning team.

NRA National Smallbore Rifle Championship Certificate Award: Certificates for 50% off Camp Perry entry fees will be awarded to winners of each class with at least 10 competitors. Only one certificate will be awarded per class of 10 or more. Classes may be combined upward (NRA Rule 9.8.1) to make a class of 10 competitors. No certificates will be awarded if there are fewer than ten total competitors entered in this Regional tournament.

Competitors may earn a maximum of one prone certificate and one position certificate per year. Both certificates may be applied to the National Smallbore Rifle Championships if the certificate winner competes in both championships. Certificates won by an ineligible competitor will be passed down to the next lower competitor in that class (e.g., if the class winner has already won a prone certificate at an earlier Regional prone tournament or is a supported shooter). Certificates awarded to competitors remain the property of the NRA which may refuse to honor any certificate for any reason at anytime,

Awards Furnished by River Bend Gun Club:

Class winners of individual fired matches and unfired aggregate matches (other than junior competitors) will receive cash awards. The value of awards will be determined by an award schedule designed to equitably distribute awards to competitors based on the number of entries in each class. The total amount of funds available for awards distribution will be approximately 60% of total receipts less tournament expenses (NRA registration fees, RBGC range fee, target costs, etc.).

A minimum of 5 entries is required to form a class and receive awards. Second place awards will be presented with 8 or more entries in a class. Third place awards will be presented with 13 or more entries in a class. Classes with insufficient entries to meet the minimum entry criterion will be promoted to a higher class (Rule 19.8.1).

A \$1 dollar coin will be awarded for each target scored 200-20X.
