

2012 NRA Conventional Prone Regional

Date: Saturday, June 2 and Sunday, June 3, 2012

Time: 9:00 am, one relay (unless more than 30 participants) we will notify participants if there is to be more than one relay

Rule: Current NRA smallbore or NRA International rifle rules will govern

Eligibility: Open to all competitors, **membership in NRA is NOT required**

Teams will consist of 2 team members a captain and/or coach if desired, and will represent either a club, rule 2.11, 2.11.1, a law enforcement agency, Rule 2.14, a regular service unit or a reserve unit (including National guard) Rule 2.13. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team.

Entries: Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using the enclosed registration entry card, accompanied by check or money order. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not an NRA member, a number will be assigned to you, for classification purposes only.

Entries Close: Individual Match entries must be received no later than Monday preceding the opening date of the tournament.

Entries Limited: Entries are limited to 80 competitors.

FEES: NRA Individual registration fee + range fee: \$35.00

Individual matches: \$2.00 each

Team match: \$20.00 per team (NRA team Fee \$5.00)

Package Fee: One day: \$45.00 / Two day: \$62.00

SOUVENIR PINS: Will be given to each individual who competes.

RIFLE: Rule 3.2

TARGET: NRA Official Targets will be used.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Books section 16.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.

AWARDS: To the Winner, 2nd, and 3rd place overall medallions (provided entries warrant) and the winning team awards in the team matches are furnished by the NRA. NRA will also provide a medal to each class winner. The tournament sponsor will provide other awards for all fired matches and aggregates. Awards for individual matches + aggregates will be 60% of match fees returned, provided by Blue Trail Range.

CLASS AND CATEGORY: NRA will provide a medal to each class winner. Award points will no longer be awarded. Camp Perry entry fee credit certificates will be provided

SPECIAL AWARDS: An individual winning a place award shall be entitled to Special Awards for which he or she is qualified, but may not win a category/class award in the same match. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor. To be eligible for a Special Award the individual must indicate on his or her entry card the groups represented.

CLASS AWARDS: The category/class awards will also be passed down, as described above, if an individual is the winner of a Special Award.

REGIONAL AWARDS SCHEDULE

GRAND AGGREGATE:

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion, 35 award points (with a minimum of 8 shooters)

2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion, 25 award points (with a minimum of 10 shooters)

3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion, 15 award points (with minimum of 15 shooters)

AWARDS FOR TEAM MATCHES - METALLIC SIGHT AND ANY SIGHT

For all team matches: A medal will be awarded each member of the team, 25 award points.

NRA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE AWARD

Certificates for 50% Off Camp Perry entry fees are awarded to Class winners. Only one award may be earned per class. At least 10 shooters must be in a class to win a certificate. Classes may be combined upward (NRA Rule 19.8.1) to make a class of 10 shooters. Regionals of less than ten shooters are not eligible for the NRA National Smallbore Rifle Championship Certificate. Certificates are won in NRA Conventional/Metric Prone Regionals and in NRA 3-Position or Conventional Position Regionals. Only one Prone certificate may be won per year. Only one Position Certificate may be earned per year. A shooter may earn one prone and one position certificate per year and both certificates may be applied to the National Smallbore Rifle Championships if a shooter desires to shoot both championships. Certificates may be passed down to the next lower shooter in a class at the same Regional tournament. The Regional winner will receive a certificate and be counted in the class to which he or she belongs. Certificates are the property of the NRA who may refuse to honor any certificates for any reason at anytime.

AWARDS FURNISHED BY TOURNAMENT SPONSOR

60% of individual match fees

CATEGORY AND CLASS AWARDS (GRAND AGGREGATE) For each class in each category:

1st Place - minimum of 5 shooters in category/class

2nd Place - with 8 or more shooters in category/class

3rd Place - with 13 or more shooters in category/class

Winner:

Metallic Sight Aggregate

Any Sight Aggregate

CATEGORY AND CLASS AWARDS: In the metallic sight aggregate or any sight aggregate. For each class in each category.

1st Place - minimum of 5 shooters in category/class

2nd Place - with 8 or more shooters in category/class

3rd Place - with 13 or more shooters in category/class

AWARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL FIRED MATCHES

The number of competitors in a class in a category will determine the amount of awards as above. Five competitors establish a class in a category, 8 competitors 2nd place, 13 competitors, 3rd etc.

AWARDS WILL BE NRA AWARD POINTS OR CASH, OR TROPHIES

Match #1: 40 shots, 50 yards, metallic sights, A-23/5 target , 20 min

Match #2: 40 shots, 50 yards/meters, metallic sights, A-26 target, 20 min

Match #3: Dewar Course, metallic sights, A-23/5 and A-25 targets, 20 min

Match #4: 40 shots, 100 yards, metallic sights, A-25 target, 20 min

Commencing at 9:00 am on June 3

Match #6: 40 shots, 50 yards, any sights, A-23/5 target, 20 min

Match #7: 40 shots, 50 yards/meters, metallic sights, A-26 target, 20 min

Match #8: Dewar Course, any sights, A-23/5 and A-25 targets, 20 min

Match #9: 40 shots, 100 yards, any sights, A-25 target, 20 min
