**LOCATION:** 9 Old South Rd. Stratford, CT

**ELIGIBILITY:** This competition is open to all competitors born in 1993 or later.

All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting.

**RESIDENCE:** Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must

declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have

a drivers license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. Non-residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state

awards.

**ENTRY:** Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will

count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships.

Shooters *may not* compete in more than one state JOSC.

Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and

are not eligible for state resident awards.

Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a drivers

license, residency is then defined as to where the competitors

parents/guardians reside.

**CATEGORIES:** The following categories will be used for the competition:

(Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2013.)

Junior (J1): Age 18-20; Competitors born from 1993 to 1995 Inter-Junior (J2): Age 15-17; Competitors born from 1996 to 1998 Sub-Junior (J3): Age 14 & under; Competitors born 1999 or later

**CLASSIFICATION:** Will be determined based on current USA Shooting classification.

Shooters without a classification will shoot in the AA class.

**RULES:** The 2011 edition of USA Shooting Rules will govern.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** Men and Women - 3 Position Smallbore Rifle:

20 Shot Prone, 20 Shots Offhand and 20 Shots Kneeling.

2 Hours and 30 Minutes block time.

There will be a 10 minute preparation period prior to the

beginning on the block time.

Men Air Rifle:

60 Shots-

Stage 1 – 20 Shots – 35 Minutes Stage 2 – 20 Shots – 35 Minutes Stage 3 – 20 Shots – 35 Minutes

Women's Air Rifle

40 Shots-

Stage 1 - 20 Shots - 37.5 Minutes Stage 2 - 20 Shots - 37.5 Minutes

FIREARM: Smallbore: Any .22 caliber rifle conforming to rule 7.4.4

Air Rifle: Any .177 air rifle conforming to rule 7.4.3.5

**SIGHTS:** Any metallic sight conforming to rule 7.4.2.3

**DISTANCE:** Smallbore: 50 feet

Air Rifle: 10 meters

**TARGETS:** Smallbore: USAS 50

Air Rifle: AR 5/10

**COACHING:** Coaching on the firing line will not be permitted.

SCORING

**PROTESTS:** A scoring protest of \$1.00 per shot may be charged.

TIES: All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules.

**PARTICIPATION** 

PINS: A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will

be given to each competitor (provided pins are requested by the

sponsor).

AWARDS: USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident

individual, silver medallion for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place resident individual. Unused

awards must be returned to USAS.

SCORE SHEETS: Only the official STATE JO SCORE REPORTING

SPREADSHEET will be accepted. No exceptions will be made and ONLY this spreadsheet will be accepted. If a different score spreadsheet is sent in to USAS, it will be rejected and we will ask you to compile the scores on the OFFICIAL STATE JO SCORE

REPORTING SPREADSHEET.

MAKE ENTRY: Entries should be made using the entry form enclosed with this

program. Mail entries to the contact person shown at the top of

the first page.

ENTRY FEES: A USA Shooting registration fee of \$8.00 per individual, per event

will be sent to USA Shooting with scores at the completion of the

match.

Total individual entry fee per event: \$25.00

ENTRIES CLOSE: Advance entries will close December 29<sup>th</sup> 2012. Entries will be

accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all

competitors who enter before the closing date.

POST ENTRIES: Entries made after the closing date will be accepted up to range

capacity. A post entry fee may be charged.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations received one week in advance, or earlier, will

receive a full refund. An additional refund schedule may be used.
