



OFFICIAL PROGRAM VETERANS' CUP

Location: Taunton, MA

Dates: November 7, November 10 and November 14, 2012

Sponsor: Taunton Rifle and Pistol Club (Junior Team) - Club House: 508-823-8024

Events: 3 Position Air Rifle 3 x 20 match, individual and team matches

Time limits: Prep Time : 10 minutes, 20 shots prone: 30 minutes Change over, prep time: 10 minutes 20 shots standing: 40 minutes, Change over, prep time: 10 minutes 20 shots kneeling: 30 minutes

Relay Schedule: Relay on November 7 will begin at 7 pm. Relays on November 10 will be at 8 am, 11 am and 2 pm as needed. Relay on November 14 will begin at 7 pm. Firing will be complete when last competitive shot is fired. A relay may start early if all competitors are present. There are 13 positions available on each relay. Additional relays will be added to accommodate shooters if needed.

Equipment Classes: Sporter and Precision Class. Individual competitors or teams may not enter in both the Sporter and Precision individual or team events in the same competition. A club, school or other organization may, however, enter individuals and one or more teams in Sporter Class competition and different individuals and one or more teams of different shooters in Precision Class competition.

Rifle and sights: Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6, metallic sights only.

Coaching: Coaching of shooters will not be permitted within the range.

Protests: A scoring protest of \$1.00 will be charged, if the protest is won the \$1.00 will be returned to the challenger. If the challenge is lost, the \$1.00 is not returned.

Competition Open To: Individuals and Teams in each equipment category. All teams consist of four competitors. Each team member must meet the eligibility criteria for the category that a team enters. Except for Organization Teams all four team members must be named before the competition starts. Teams must represent a club, school, JROTC unit or other similar organization.

A two person Team category will consist of two shooters who normally shoot in matches together at the same club/school. Awards for the top three teams will consist of items on a prize table.



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Rules: The National Standard CMP Three-Position Air Rifles will apply. *The range requires eye protection and ear plugs be worn during all matches.* Please do not sign up for the match if you consider this safety requirement to be an issue. Empty Barrel Indicators MUST be used by all competitors.

Awards (Sporter and Precision Rifles): 1st, 2nd, 3rd Junior and 1st, 2nd, 3rd Open medals for each equipment class will be given. National Three Position Air Rifle Council Achievement Award Pins will be given to qualifying individuals. Top five positions of first time shooters will receive an award in each equipment class. High Age Group I, II and III will receive an award in each equipment class. Team awards will be given for First, Second and Third place in each equipment class. EIC points are being awarded by CMP; please see their website (odcmp.org) for details.

Range Location: 430 East Britannia Street, Taunton, MA (Follow Route 138 to intersection of 138 and Britannia Street, the range is located near the entrance to the Taunton Dump). Further directions can be found at the website <http://www.tauntonrifleandpistol.org/ranges.htm>.

Entry Fees: \$10.00 per competitor \$10 per Team (\$5 for an individual entering their first match)

Email entries may be sent up until the last day before the desired relay is to be shot. The least preferred method of entry is by phone at 774-473-7934.

Accommodations: A list of accommodations can be obtained by contacting Sid Martin via email at sidm3@aol.com. There are local hotels in Taunton and Raynham. No special event housing has been negotiated with any local hotels. Food will be available at the match to be held on November 10, 2012. Water will be available for purchase on all match days.

Other: Teams may be entered in this match at \$10 per team. Teams must be declared prior to the first team member's relay. A shooter can participate on only one team.
