1. Range Location: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 miles north of Phoenix, AZ. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy. (exit 223). Competitors will enter through the main gate on Carefree Highway.

2. Facilities: A camping area, with electricity, water & toilet facilities is available, during the matches for a fee. Soft drinks and water are available, but you are advised to bring your own lunch.

3. Accommodations: See club website for a list of local hotels and campsites at www.desertsharpshooters.com

4. Rules: Current NRA Conventional Smallbore Rifle Rules will apply. Rule 3.2 defines the rifle to be used.

5. Eligibility: Open to anyone.

6. Advanced Entries are required: All entries must be paid in advance.

7. Individual Entries: Make entry in individual events on the attached Registration & Entry Form (include NRA ID#). Entries MUST be accompanied by check, money order or NRA award points made payable to Mid Tompkins. Those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee.

8. Entries Close: 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 8, 2011. Entries received after this time are considered late entries and will be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays.

9. Entry Limits: 90 Individual entries.

10. Fees:

All individual matches Saturday & Sunday adults: \$45.00

All individual matches Saturday & Sunday juniors: \$20.00 (no awards)

Saturday or Sunday (any one day only), adults: \$35.00

Saturday or Sunday (any one day only), juniors: \$10.00

11. Challenge Fee: \$3.00. The challenge fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

12. Practice Firing: The match fees do not include Ben Avery Range fees for individuals practicing before the match. Those wishing to practice on Friday March 8, must pay a \$10.00 range fee at that time.

13. Empty Chamber Indicator: Approved NRA "empty chamber indicators" are required to be used at all times except during the preparation time and firing of your relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat office for \$1.00 each.
14. Squadding: All matches will be pre-squadded. Squadding tickets will be issued at

the stat office before the matches. Be prepared to show NRA membership cards and NRA Smallbore Rifle classification card when picking up squadding tickets.

15. Scoring: Competitors may be required to score. Any competitor failing to perform scoring duties may be disqualified.

16. Classification: NRA Conventional Smallbore Prone Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" or 19.2 "Temporary Classification" may be used. Those unclassified or without proof of classification will be required to compete in the Master Class.

17. Competitors: Competitors must furnish their own target-mounting clips and will hang their own unfired targets.

18. Firing Time: Firing will begin at 9:00 a.m. each day. Competitors should plan to arrive by 8:00 a.m. to allow sufficient set up time.

19. Awards: NRA Regional Medallions will be awarded to the top three finishers regardless of Classification. Cash will be given to match winners and the high scorer in each class that has five or more entries. If there are fewer than five entries in any class or category they will be combines with the next higher class or category until a combination of classes has at least five entries.

21. Courses of Fire: Metallic sight matches will be fired on Saturday and the any-sight matches will be fired on Sunday.

22. Any-Sights (Saturday & Sunday): There will be an Any-Sight division; Awards will be given for any-sights on Saturday if there are enough entries. On Sunday you will be combined with the other any-sight shooters. You will not be eligible for the Regional Awards.

23. F-Class: There will be an F-Class division. Awards will be given if there are enough entries. You will not be eligible for the Regional Awards.
