Course of Fire: One NCAA/USA Shooting half course smallbore 3 x20 (60 shots) and one air rifle match (60 shots) will be fired and counted for both individual and team scores. NCAA teams will follow current NCAA squadding rules, other teams (club/jr) do not have to fire as a unit. Teams must be designated prior to the match.

Rules: The current 2013/14 NCAA/USA Shooting Rifle Rules will be in effect.

*In accordance with the 2013/14 NCAA Rifle Rules, this match will not require compliance with USA Shooting rules 7.5.4.5 (shooting jacket support arm seam), 7.5.2.3 & 7.5.3.5 (shoe sole dimensions) and 7.5.5.3 (trouser reinforcements).

Targets: Megalink Electronic Scoring Systems will be used with the current USA 50ft and

USA 10m air rifle target specifications.

Competitors: Teams must consist of up to 5 members from an NCAA team, collegiate club team,

or affiliated junior/scholastic team. Individuals not meeting this requirement may

compete in the open category.

Coaching: Coaching on the firing line is not permitted.

NCAA The NCAA Rifle Committee has granted a "shoulder to shoulder" exemption for this

match.

Exemption: *This rule applies only to NCAA Teams.

Entries: Advance entries are required and relay assignments will be given in the order they

are reserved.
