SPONSORING ORGANIZATION: Connecticut State Rifle & Revolver Association, Inc. (CSRRA) and the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, New London, Connecticut. This match will be the official state qualifier for Connecticut residents qualifying for the National JOSCs to receive possible support from the CSRRA (based on available funding).

DATES OF MATCH: December 13 thru December 15, 2013 (allows for collegiate JRs to compete!)

CITY / STATE LOCATION: U.S. Coast Guard Academy, New London, Connecticut

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all competitors born in **1994** or later. **All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting. Membership application attached to this program** or sign-up online at <http://usashooting.org/membership.php>.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. **Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a driver's license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside.** Non-residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards.

ENTRY: Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters ***may not*** compete in more than one state JOSC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards. Be sure that you completed the form legibly, signed, dated, and completed all information (emails will be used by USA Shooting to contact you).

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for the competition: (Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2014.)
Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 1994-1996
Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 1997-1999
Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 2000 or later.

RULES: 2013 Edition of USA Shooting rules will govern. Coaching on the firing line **will not** be allowed.

COURSE OF FIRE & TIME LIMIT (Electronic Targets):

Smallbore Rifle: 1 hour, 45 minutes. Sighting is included in the 15 minutes (men/women)

Womens Air Rifle: 50 minutes (40 shots), 33 feet

Mens Air Rifle: 1 hour, 15 minutes (60 shots), 33 feet

Metallic Sights

Combined Prep/Sighting Time for ALL Events: 15-minute

FIREARM & Equipment: See detailed descriptions in the 2013 USA Shooting Rule Book

TARGETS: Electronic (Coast Guard)

SCORING/TIMES/TIES/PROTESTS: Please refer to the 2013 USA Shooting Rule Book

PARTICIPATION PINS: A JO participation pin will be provided.

AWARDS: **Provided by USA Shooting** – USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual.

ENTRY FEES: USA Shooting Registration Fee: \$8.00 per individual per match.
Match Fee: \$10 (whether you shoot one match or two).
Total Individual Entry Fee: \$18 (one match) or \$26 (two matches)

ENTRIES CLOSE: Fri, 12/6. Post entries will be accepted up to range capacity. Cancellations received by 12/6 will receive a full refund.
