AWARDS:

NRA WILL PROVIDE GOLD, SILVER AND BRONZE REGIONAL *MEDALIONS* (GOLD with minimum 8 competitors, SILVER minimum 10 competitors BRONZE minimum 15 competitors in each Regional), PLUS, EACH CLASS WINNER (match winner will automatically win his class), 10 or more in each class, WILL RECEIVE A 50% OFF CERTIFICATE TO A PRONE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. If a class winner has already won one certificate, (prone) the certificate will be passed down to the runner up in the class. A shooter is allowed to win one certificate per discipline, each year. Rest of awards to be determined. Aggregate winners not eligible for class awards, except the certificate. In team match, 1 award per 3 teams.

NRA will provide a medal to each class winner with a minimum of five (5) in the class.

Directions to Range: From South, Rt. 80 or 287 or 46 to route 23 north. Continue on rt. 23N past Oak Ridge Reservoir (on left) to Canistear Road (about 12 miles north of Rt. 287. GPS LOCATOR TO THIS INTERSECTION: Long. 74.29.32 West, LAT 41.4.52 North). Right turn onto Canistear Rd for about 4.2 miles to Range Road. Right turn into property, at first junction, left turn down the hill to smallbore parking (on your left). From north, rt. 84 to rt. 23 south to Canistear Rd, make left turn at light onto Canistear Rd and follow above directions. 100 Range Road, Highland Lakes, NJ 07422. Do not use the range address for GPS as it will not get you into the property.
