	From the West: Take Rt. 101 to Rt. 101A East. Turn onto the Everett Turnpike South.
	From the Everett Turnpike: Take Exit 2 off the Everett Tpk.and follow the signs towards Hudson going over the Merrimack River. After crossing the Merrimack stay in the right lane and turn
	onto Rt. 3A South (Sam's Club on right and Wal-Mart on left). At 3 rd set of lights stay straight (right lane) to continue on Rt. 3A. Go about about 1½ miles to next lights. (Watch for HFGC sign.) Turn left at lights onto Pine Rd. Club is ¼ mile on left. Use glass door entrance on left of building.
Rules:	 NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern. Use of OBI/ECI is mandatory. Ear protection is mandatory. Eye protection is strongly recommended.
Match Open To:	 Open competitors from any state Junior competitors from any state (rule 2.3) Only competitors who reside in New Hampshire may earn the State Champion title.
Match Entry Fees:	 Match entry fee is \$20.00 in total for each individual entry. This includes: Range fee of \$11.50 NRA registration fee of \$5.50 State registration fee of \$3.00 Team entry is \$6.00 for the 2 person team
Entries:	E-mail or call the contact person on the first page to reserve an entry. Entries close Tuesday, Mar 31 2015.

Post Entries	Post Entries will be accepted until the relay is called to the firing line. A Post Entry fee of \$3.00 will be added.
Entry Limit:	The match is limited to 35 competitors. Seven per relay maximum.
Relays:	Firing begins: Relay 1: Sat, April 4 - 9:00 AM Relay 2: Sat, April 4 - 11:30 AM An additional relay may be added at approx 2:00 PM on Sat, April 4 only if all
	other relays fill and there is a minimum of three competitors.
Categories:	Open, Junior, Intermediate Junior, Sub Junior.
Teams:	 An unfired <u>two</u> person team match is available. A team may register until the relay for any one team member is called to the firing line. No team may be created that includes a competitor who has already fired.
Awards:	 Award plaques available for overall State Champion and Junior State Champion plus plaques for J, IJ and SJ categories. Category awards require two or more competitors. 2nd place award if six or more, 3rd place if 11, etc. A Team award is available if two or more teams enter. 50% of Open entry fees (minus cost of the above plaque) will be returned in the form of cash awards. First place if two or more Open competitors, 2nd place if six or more, 3rd place if 11, etc. High Score for Match 1-4 will receive a High Score Certificate. There will be no classification based awards
	If the overall State Champion is a Junior, the Junior State Champion title will then be awarded to the next highest Junior competitor.
Course of Fire:	 All shots fired on A-17 targets in the following order: Match 1: 20 shots Prone – 20 minutes Match 2: 20 shots Standing – 30 minutes Match 3: 20 shots Sitting – 20 minutes Match 4: 20 shots Kneeling – 20 minutes Match 5: Aggregate of matches 1-4.
Equipment:	 Any .22 caliber rimfire rifle conforming to NRA rule 3.2. Junior competitors - Metallic sights only conforming to NRA rule 3.7a.
