Fee: None

Rules: USAS International Rifle Rules, with NCAA and local exceptions.

Eligibility: The competitors must be intermediate and advanced level shooters.

Course Of Fire: Three Position (3x20) and International Standing Precision Air Rifle (60 shots).

Distance: . Firing for Smallbore will be at 48ft on an appropriately reduced target and scoring system. Air Rifle will be at 10 Meters.

Special Conditions:

A federal and/or state government photo I.D for each person is required to come aboard the US Coast Guard Academy.

College/University teams (NCAA and Club) may shoot with a five (5) person team, but count high four (4) scores.

High School/Junior Club teams will shoot with a four (4) person team and count four (4). Recognizing that not all High School/Junior Club teams have shooting jackets which meet USAS rules a liberal view will be taken. However, no 'Hardback' style coats will be allowed.

Each College/University or High School/Junior Club may bring one team for both Smallbore and Air Rifle.. They each may bring up to three additional shooters to compete as individual competitors, depending on available space. Priority goes to complete teams.

Two frame hits may be cause for disqualification.

Competitors under eighteen (18) are required to have a sponsor with appropriate Power of Attorney and medical insurance information.

Participants and guests may eat in the Wardroom at \$7.70 per meal. If teams so desire, they must let us know by 7 November 2016. Payment will be at time of meal, cash only.

Empty chamber indicators are required.

Hearing and Eye protection are required during smallbore competition.

Participants are responsible for the security and storage of their personal items and equipment. DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING ON THE RANGE OVERNIGHT.

Accommodations and Travel: All expenses and reservations for lodging, travel to and from this competition, local transportation, etc. are the responsibility of the attendees.

The nearest major airport to the Academy is either Providence, Rhode Island or Hartford, Connecticut. Both are about one hour away by car.

Directions:

From New Haven, New York City and Other Points West:

Take I-95 North to Exit 82A (Frontage Road).
Take Briggs Street exit off Frontage Road.
Turn left on Briggs Street at the traffic light at the top of the exit ramp.
Continue on Briggs Street through three traffic lights. You will now be on Mohegan Avenue.
The Academy's Main Gate will be on your right immediately after the third traffic light.

From Norwich and Worcester:

Take I-395 South to Exit 78 (Route 32 South)
Continue on Route 32 approximately 3 miles.
Take exit to I-95 South to New Haven.
Turn right onto Briggs Street at stop sign at top of exit ramp.
Turn right on Williams Street at next stop sign.
Cross bridge and turn left on Mohegan Avenue at first traffic light.
The Academy's Main Gate will be on your right.

From Hartford:

Take Route 2 South to Route 11 to the end.
Turn left to go to Route 85 in Salem.
Take Route 85 South to I-95 North.
Get on Route I-95 North for a VERY SHORT 1/4 MILE distance.
Exit on Service Road to Briggs Street exit.
Turn left on Briggs Street at the top of the exit ramp.
Continue on Briggs Street through three traffic lights. You will now be on Mohegan Avenue.
The Academy's Main Gate will be on your right immediately after the third traffic light.

From Providence, Boston and Other Points East:

Take I-95 South to Exit 83 (Frontage Road).
Take Briggs Street Exit off Frontage Road.
Turn left on Briggs Street at the traffic light at the top of the exit ramp.
Continue on Briggs Street through two traffic lights. You will now be on Mohegan Avenue.
The Academy's Main Gate will be on your right immediately after the second traffic light.

Special Academy Traffic Regulations

The speed limit is 15 mph.
Speed bumps and radar are used to enforce the speed limit.
All vehicles must yield to pedestrians and marching sections.
Most parking spaces are reserved. Park in spaces marked as open parking or visitor parking.
Please have all adult passenger photo identification available upon approaching the security gate. Any vehicle, and its occupants, entering the United States Coast Guard Academy are subject to random security searches by uniformed security officers.
