Time:	<b>Match – 1<sup>st</sup> relay 8am to 10am 2<sup>nd</sup> relay 10:30am to 1pm 3<sup>rd</sup> relay 1:30pm to 3:30pm</b>
Location:	Reading Rifle and Revolver Club, Haverhill St., Reading MA
Eligibility:	Firing Individual Juniors and Junior Teams will be eligible for an invite from the CMP to the 3p air finals. Invites are determined by the CMP per State. Precision and Sporter Teams and Individual are eligible.
Teams:	Teams will consist of 4 Firing Junior Members in either precision or sporter
Rules:	National Standard three-Position Air Rifle rules will apply
Course of Fire:	Air Rifle : 3 x 20, 20 prone, 20 off-hand, 20 kneeling
Time limits:	Prep and sighting time (prone) - 8 minutes 20 shots prone for record - 20 minutes.....Change over time: 5 minutes Sighting time (off-hand) - 5 minutes 20 shots standing: 25 minutes.....Change over time: 5 minutes Sighting time (kneeling) - 5 minutes 20 shots kneeling: 20 minutes **Time will expire when the last competitor is finished. The clock will not be allowed to run out. Time expires; competitors will go forward and change targets (3min), when the last competitor is back from hanging targets the 5 min change over period will begin. Followed by the 5 min sighting period.
Rifle:	Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6
Sights:	Metallic sights only; Rule 4.2.5
Targets:	Air Rifle - AR 5/10 (10 record bulls)
Distance:	Air Rifle – Ten (10) meters (approx. 33 feet)
Coaching:	Coaching will not be permitted.
Protests:	A scoring protest of \$2.00 will be charged, if the protest is won the \$2.00 will be returned to the challenger. If the challenge is lost, the \$2.00 is not returned.
Awards:	Gold, Silver, Bronze Medals to the 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place winners Men & Women
Entry Fees:	Air Rifle Match - \$20.00      Team Fees: \$20.00
Range Capacity:	The capacity of each relay is fourteen (12) competitors
Directions:	<b>From Boston--</b> Take I-93N to Exit 37A. Merge onto I-95 N towards Peabody. Take I-95 exit 40 towards Wakefield Ctr/North Reading. Coming off of the ramp, go around the rotary and go back under 128, staying in the right lane. Haverhill St. is the first street on the right (National Guard Base on your right). Continue on Haverhill for approx. one mile. On your right will be a sign for Burlington Ice Arena and Reading Rifle & Revolver.
