Location:	Woburn Sportsman Association, Bedford MA
Eligibility:	This competition is open to all US Citizens born in 1996 or later. Competitors <u>must</u> also be an individual member of USA Shooting. Application is attached if junior is not a member.
Residence:	Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residences are eligible for the 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place USA Shooting State Champion Medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a drivers license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. Non-Residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards.
Entry:	Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the national Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters <b><u>MAY NOT</u></b> compete in more than one state JORC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JORC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JORC and those who cannot attend their own state JORC will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.
Teams:	Teams will consist of 4 Firing Members Teams must be submitted before the start of each match. There must be at least 5 teams entered for awards.
Categories:	The following categories will be used for the individual and team competition based on the age the competitor will be in the year <b>2015</b> <b>J1 - Junior - age 18 to 20 – 1999 - 1998 - 1997</b> <b>J2 - Int Jr - age 15 to 17 – 2002 – 2001 - 2000</b> <b>J3 - Sub Jr - age 14 and under, born 2003 or later.</b>
Rules:	Current USA Shooting Rules will govern the competition. 2013 rules will govern all competitions. A few exception to the State level competitions are: ** The boot flexor is not required nor do you need to test for it. **The jacket seam rule is not being enforced.

	**The butt pad rule IS being enforced. Ensure that all of your athletes remove this piece from their pants.
Course of Fire:	Small-bore (Men and Women): 60 shots (20 prone, 20 standing, 20 kneeling) Air Rifle (Men) 60 shots, (Women) 40 shots,
Time limits: “NEW”	Small-bore: 3 x 20 50ft (Stationary Target time limit rules) Each stage will begin with a 3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep) 10 shots prone: 13 minutes with unlimited sighters target change over 3 minutes 3 minute prep 10 shots prone: 13 minutes with unlimited sighters (ten minute equipment and target change over) 3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep) 10 shots standing: 19 minutes with unlimited sighters 3minute target change 10 shots standing: 19 minutes with unlimited sighters (ten minute equipment and target change over) 10 shots kneeling: 15 minutes with unlimited sighters 3 minute target change 10 shots kneeling: 15 minutes with unlimited sighters **Once all shooting is complete the clock will be stopped, time will not be allowed to run out in each stage)  Air rifle: Each stage will begin with a 3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep) Men – 60 shots – to be shot in 6 stages of 10 shots. Each stage will be shot in a time limit of 15 minutes with unlimited sighters. Women – 40 shots – to be shot in 4 stages of 10 shots. Each stage will be shot in a time limit of 15 minutes with unlimited sighters. **In addition to the 3 minute prep there will be a 3 minute change over period between stages **Once all shooting is complete the clock will be stopped, time will not be allowed to run out in each stage)
Rifle:	Small-bore: Any .22 cal. Rifle meeting USAS rules 4.2 and 4.3 Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6
Sights:	Metallic sights only; Rule 4.2.5
Targets:	Small-bore – Orion Small-bore Targets Air Rifle – Orion 10m Air Rifle Targets
Distance:	Small-bore – Fifty (50) feet Air Rifle – Ten (10) meters (approx. 33 feet)
Coaching:	Coaching will not be permitted.
Protests:	A scoring protest of \$3.00 will be charged, if the protest is won the \$1.00 will be returned to the challenger. If the challenge is lost, the \$3.00 is not returned.
Ties:	All ties will be broken according to USA Shooting rules.
Participation Pins:	A Junior Olympic Participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.
Awards:	USA Shooting will provide a Gold, Silver and Bronze medallion to the 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place resident individual in both small-bore and air rifle.

Range Capacity:	The capacity of each relay is ten (10) competitors

<b><u>Please Note:</u></b> <u>ALL State champions will be invited provided they shoot above the following scores:</u> <u>Women’s Air Rifle – 300, Men’s Air Rifle – 500, Men’s and Women’s Small-bore – 500.</u>
