Sunday December 18, 2016– Eastern USAMU Junior Small-bore/Air Championship

Directions:

WSA is located at 155 Middlesex Turnpike in Bedford, MA (Exit 32 on Route 128) approximately 1.5 miles north of the Middlesex Turnpike and Route 62 intersection. WSA is on the right hand side (heading north) across from the Oak Park Executive Park.

Registration:

Mail all entries to Maureen Trickett 4 George Avenue, Woburn MA 01801. Email will not be accepted, the match is on a first come basis for registration.

Small-bore (Men and Women):

60 shots (20 prone, 20 standing, 20 kneeling)

Air Rifle (Men) 60 shots, (Women) 40 shots,

Course of fire:

Small-bore: 3 x 20 50ft (Stationary Target time limit rules) (USA Shooting)

Each stage will begin with a 3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep)

10 shots prone: 13 minutes with unlimited sighters

target change over 3 minutes

3 minute prep

10 shots prone: 13 minutes with unlimited sighters

(ten minute equipment and target change over)

3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep)

10 shots standing: 19 minutes with unlimited sighters

3minute target change

10 shots standing: 19 minutes with unlimited sighters

(ten minute equipment and target change over)

10 shots kneeling: 15 minutes with unlimited sighters

3 minute target change

10 shots kneeling: 15 minutes with unlimited sighters

**Once all shooting is complete the clock will be stopped, time will not be allowed to run out in each stage)

Air rifle:

Each stage will begin with a 3 minute prep (no sighter shots are allowed during prep)

Men – 60 shots – to be shot in 6 stages of 10 shots.

Each stage will be shot in a time limit of 15 minutes with unlimited sighters.

Women – 40 shots – to be shot in 4 stages of 10 shots.

Each stage will be shot in a time limit of 15 minutes with unlimited sighters.

**In addition to the 3 minute prep there will be a 3 minute change over period between stages

**Once all shooting is complete the clock will be stopped, time will not be allowed to run out in each stage)

Relay times:

Sunday December 18, 2016 Small-bore: Range 1

Relay one – 8am

Relay two – 11am

Relay three – 2pm

Sunday December 18, 2016 Air Rifle, both men and women Range 2

Relay # 1 - 8am

Relay # 2 – 11 am

Relay #3 – 2pm

Range capacity for both air and smallbore is 10 competitors per relay.

Awards:

First overall winner for both smallbore and air rifle will receive a Championship plaque and their name will go on the trophy. Category awards will also be given. Smallbore 1st J1, J2, J3 - Air Rifle Top (Men) J1,J2, J3 and (Women) J1,J2,J3 . Winners will receive only one award.

Awards will be presented at the end of all matches. Trophies and medals will not be mailed. If a winner is not present, the award will be held until the next match or they arrange shipping for the award.

Match Fees:

Total Entry Fees are as follows:

Small-bore - \$25.00

Air Rifle - \$25.00

USAMU Postal Match -

We will be running along with the Air match entries to be entered for the USAMU Postal match. This will be basically an unfired match based on the shots from the fired air match. The match is 60 shots for both male and females.

So if a female wishes to also enter the Postal match they will be required to shoot all 6 targets. If they do not want to enter the match they will only have to shoot the required 40 shots for the championship match.

No awards will be given out for this postal. All results will be posted on the Orion site. Additional information on this match is found after the registration page in this match bulletin.

Cost to enter the USAMU Postal match:

\$10.00 per competitor. Checks are to be made out to Maureen Trickett, Please note that this is for the AMU Postal match.

****Coaching is not permitted in any event. If a coach is caught coaching, they will receive a verbal warning and if seen again both the coach and the competitor will be disqualified.**

2017 US Army National Air Rifle Championship

Sectionals: 1 October 2016 – 16 December 2016

National Championship: 27-29 January 2017

SUMMARY: The 2017 USANARC features a competition format that gives all participants a true shoulder-to-shoulder competition after experiencing a state sectional and a national qualification competition. Competitors will fire Air Rifle Competitions throughout the nation, where their targets will be scored using the Orion Scoring Systems. By utilizing the Orion scoring system, the scores will be uploaded into a national results list that displays state and national rankings in real time. The U. S. Army Marksmanship Unit is administering the championship and will provide the national medals and awards. In addition to the air rifle competition, USAMU will host an optional 50 Meter 3 Position competition. Only Athletes who qualified for the air rifle championship will be eligible to enter the smallbore competition that will be conducted on Friday, 27 January 2017.

NATIONAL SPONSORSHIP: The U. S. Army is sponsoring this youth national championship to promote the development of rifle marksmanship skills among American youth and to recognize those who respond to this challenge. The U. S. Army Marksmanship Unit (<http://www.usamu.com>) at Fort Benning, Georgia is administering this competition in cooperation with Orion Scoring Systems (<http://www.orionscoringsystem.com>) that is providing scoring services and results management for the 2017 Championships.

COMPETITION EVENTS: USANARC offers competition in the following events:

SPORTER CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- Individual Three-Position Sporter Air Rifle - 3x20
- Team Three-Position Sporter Air Rifle - 3x20

PRECISION CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- Individual Standing Precision Air Rifle - 60 shots
- Team, Standing Precision Air Rifle - 60 shots

THREE POSITION SMALLBORE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- Individual Three-Position Smallbore - 3x20

Teams competing in state sectionals will consist of five members, with the top 4 scores to count as the team total. (Rule: 3.2.3, Best-Four-Count teams)

Teams invited to the national will abide by rule 3.2, teams that consist of four athletes; however, one alternate firing member per team is authorized to attend. If not used as a team member, they will shoot as an individual. *There will be no invitations given by attrition.*

OPEN JUNIOR COMPETITION. This Championship is open to all junior shooting organizations and individual juniors who are school age (rule: 3.1) or younger. All school age youth are invited to participate, whether as individuals or as members of their club or school team. Schools and clubs are encouraged to enter as many individual shooters and teams as they can. It is not required to be a member of a club or school team to compete. A major objective of this competition is to give the experience and challenge of this unique state and national competition to as many junior shooters as possible; to include three-position sporter and international standing precision.

RULES: Current edition of the *National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules*, and this official program will govern the conduct of the competitions; the current edition of the USA Shooting rules will govern the conduct of the smallbore competition.

COMPETITION DATES: All 2016 USANARC sectional competitions will take place between 1 October 2016 and 16 December 2016; national competition will take place 27-29 January 2017; with smallbore events occurring on 27 January 2017 concurrent with the air rifle practice. Competitors opting to participate in the smallbore competition will be provided with an opportunity to prepare for the air rifle matches during the afternoon of 27 January. Equipment checks will be accomplished on Friday, 27 January for air rifle competitors. Equipment checks will not be conducted for the smallbore competition.

SECTIONAL COMPETITIONS (1 Oct 2016 – 16 Dec 2016): All USANARC sectional competitions will be hosted by match sponsors who use the Orion Scoring System. The sectional matches will be shoulder-to-shoulder competitions open to all teams, clubs and individual junior shooters in that area. Orion scoring will ensure that all targets nationwide are scored according to the same standard. Orion scoring also will allow immediate, direct uploading of fired scores into an online match bulletin that shows current state and national rankings as well as final results immediately after the last match. The match website www.orionresults.com/usamu will list all approved match sponsors so that interested teams and shooters can contact them to enter.

NATIONAL COMPETITION 27-29 January 2017: The 2017 USANARC National Championship will be by *invitation* only. The top 25 precision and sporter individuals and the top 20 teams in both disciplines will be invited to Fort Benning GA for the National Championships. Invitees will be based on scores posted onto the Orion scoring system for the states sectionals. The national championship will be shot on the Suis Ascor electronic scoring system at the US Army Marksmanship Unit's Pool Indoor range.

SMALLBORE COMPETITION 27 January 2017: Due to repeated requests, USAMU will host an optional Three Position Smallbore competition. The smallbore match is only open for Athletes who have already qualified for the air rifle competition. Competitor check in for the match will begin at 8:00 on the morning of the competition and the match will start at 10:00. Athletes must pre-register for the 50M match by using the same entry form as the Air Rifle match.

CHAMPIONSHIP BANQUET AND AWARDS CEREMONY: The 2017 USANARC banquet and awards ceremony will be hosted by the National Rifle Association. After the finals on Sunday 29 January 2017, the awards ceremony and banquet will take place. Tickets for competitors and one coach will be distributed at in-processing. For all others wishing to attend the banquet and awards ceremony, tickets may be purchased in advance for \$20.00 each. You may purchase these extra tickets when upon checking in of your competitor(s) for the championship.

HOW TO ENTER: Teams, clubs or individuals that wish to enter the USANARC should check the Orion website listing of match sponsors at www.orionresults.com/usamu. They should contact the closest match sponsor that is offering a date and location best suited for them and submit their match entry directly to that match sponsor.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee for state and regional sectional individual competitors is \$6.00 each and is paid to the host club for their target and administrative fees. There is no additional entry fee for teams.

AWARDS: The highest scoring individuals and teams in each state will be the US Army Junior Air Rifle Sectional Champions. The 25 highest scoring individuals and 20 highest scoring teams in the nation will be invited to the US Army Marksmanship Unit for the National Championship. Awards will be provided by USAMU as follows:

- **National Individual Championship:**

- Gold national medal, and a Trophy for the National Champion.

- Silver national medal, and a Trophy for the 2nd place individual.

- Bronze national medal, and a Trophy for the 3rd place individual.

- Certificate of Excellence for 4th through 6th place individuals.

- **National Team Championship:**

- Gold national medals, and Team Trophy.

- Silver national medals, and Team Trophy.

- Bronze national medals, and Team Trophy.

- Certificate of Excellence for 4th through 6th place teams.
